ABSTRACT

If the form of government respond to the question of who exercises political power in a society (a person, group of persons or the population as a whole), to define the political regime in a society, is placing us within highlighting methods or procedures through these people govern. In connection with these arrangements and processes of government, constitutional doctrine captures the political regime in two ways: constitutional political system in which state bodies act within the basic law, the constitution and the absolute political regime in which such limitations do not exist. Based on the same criteria, making methods, the government can make distinction between liberal regimes in which government is conducted with respect for individual freedoms and authoritarian regimes, resulting in the preeminence that recognizes the interests of the state.
