ABSTRACT

In Romania, the legal lawful framework regarding the illicit circuit of the narcotic substances is provided by the Law No. 143/2000 on combating the drugs illicit trafficking. In this regard, in order to ensure the compliance with the legal provisions on narcotic substances, are specifically designated compartments within the police that, according to the duties they have based on the laws in force and through the cooperation with specialists from the Ministry of Health, General Directorate of Customs and with other units of the Ministry of Home Affairs, which have the right and duty to monitor and control the activity with narcotic substances in all the segments of the legal circuit and act to combat the illicit trafficking.
