ABSTRACT

Terror was used preventively by Spartans in order to preserve the balance of power between the ruling class and the enslaved one, this being one of the principles in which the existence of that State was redundantly with human civilization, the awareness of the existence of "terror" and violence being disseminated around in order for masters.
